Locations

International students are placed in safe rural communities all around Southwestern Manitoba. Our priority is to identify a host family and community that is the best match for you.

The schools of Study Manitoba School Divisions are public schools located in the Southwestern corner of Manitoba. The region is known to be quiet and safe and is in close proximity to Brandon, the second largest city in Manitoba.

Our schools are staffed by government certified employees and the curriculum is government approved.

Community Profile

The communities represented by Study Manitoba are farming communities with rich histories and deep roots. The towns provide a small town atmosphere with all the amenities of a larger center. Most towns have recreational facilities such as swimming pools, golf courses, soccer fields, skating and curling rinks, museums and camping facilities. Application Checklist

A completed application package includes the following:

- Student/homestay application form completed online
- Original or certified copies of transcripts or school records from the previous two years of school (translated into English)
- A letter of recommendation from the Principal/Director of your school
- · A recent photo in JPG format
- A copy of TOEFL or other English language test (optional)

Once accepted into our program, you will receive a letter of acceptance. You must then apply to the nearest Canadian Embassy or High Commission for your study permit.
